

"Meltdown" and "Spectre" Security Notice

As you are most likely aware, vulnerabilities in CPUs from Intel and other manufacturers allow malicious programs to steal potentially sensitive data from other processes on the computer. Newly released guidance from VMware and Microsoft state that virtualization hosts running vSphere ESXi or Hyper-V are at increased risk as they may allow for information disclosure between virtual machines running on the same host.
